

Dental health and children: quick facts



57.5% of eligible Australian children are not using the Medicare Child Dental Benefits Schedule.



2,000 children aged 0-8 years are hospitalised for dental treatment.



Children are 3 times less likely to attend school if they have dental pain.

39 clinics
across South Australia.



80,000 children come to SA Dental for dental care each year.



More than 40% of Australian children have untreated tooth decay when starting school.



Tooth decay is the most common childhood disease - over 4 times more common than asthma.



1/5 of Australian children drink four or more glasses of sugar sweetened beverages in a usual day.



33% of Australian children do not brush their teeth twice a day.
