

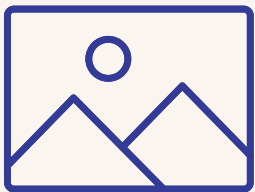

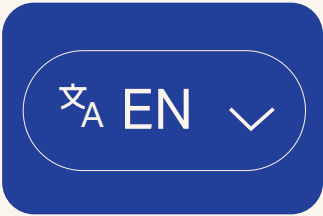

issued by a department of the Australian
Government.

If you have a Pensioner Concession Card, your name will be printed on it under the words SOUTH AUSTRALIA.



Pensioner Concession Card from Services Australia.



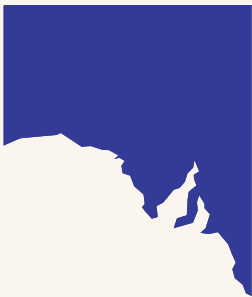
Pensioner Concession Card from the Department of Veterans' Affairs.

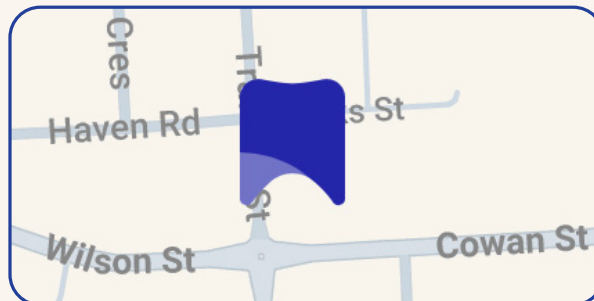

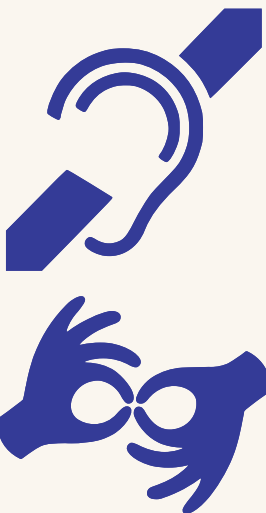
When you contact us



If you visit a SA Dental clinic or call a clinic, we will ask you if you have a current concession card.



If you visit a clinic, we will want to see your concession card so please take it with you.

We will ask you some questions



Your name



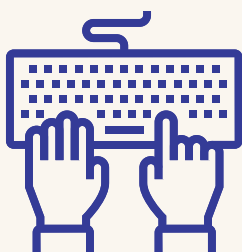
Your **address**



Your date of birth - day / month / year



Your phone number



All this information will be typed into
our SA Dental client record program.



Your information is **private**.

We won't tell anyone your information without asking you first.



So that we can help you, we will then ask you questions.

We may ask you:

"Have you been to a SA Dental clinic before?"

"Why do you want an appointment with SA Dental?"





We will also ask you if you have a person who we can share your dental information with.



If you do want to share information about your dental care with another person, you can fill out a form called 'Consent to Share Information' and we will put this with your client record.

What do these words mean?

Address	Where you live
Co-payment	Fee paid for dental care
Eligible	Able to use SA Dental. Sometimes you have to answer questions before you can use SA Dental
Email address	For getting messages and letters, like: max.molar@sadental.com.au
Frequently	Common/often
Private	We only share information if we need to and are allowed to
